2022 Show Rules

Division/Class Clarification

- Lead Line-Riders age 7 & under as of January 1st of current year.
- Walk-Riders any age. Riders may not show in trot or lope classes. Once rider shows in a trot or lope class with SIEG they are no longer eligible for the Walk Division
- Rookie-Rider of any age who as of January 1st of current year is limited to 3 years or less of show experience. Less than 10 points in any association and cannot have won a high point award. Rider must complete an Affidavit for Rookie Division and be approved by Board/Officers.
- *Rookie riders are not allowed to show in lope classes.
- Pony-Riders 12 years or younger as of January 1st of the current year. Pony must be 56" or shorter, ponies may be measured.
- Youth-Riders 18 years or younger as of January 1st of the current year.
- Amateur-Riders age 19 years and older as of January 1st of the current year. No trainers allowed.
- Open-Any age rider. Except for ranch classes.
- Select-Riders age 50 years and older as of January 1st of the current year.
- Color Breed Halter- Any horse of color that is or could be registered into a color breed association. Example APHA, Pinto, Buckskin, Palomino, Appaloosa, Roan, ect.
- Grand and Reserve Halter-Top 2 horses from Mare and Gelding Youth Halter will automatically be entered into this class, no entry fee required. Top 2 horses from Mare and Gelding Open Halter and top 2 horses from Color Breed Halter will automatically be entered into this class, no entry fee required.
- All Around and Reserve All Around-will be awarded in the following divisions: Rookie, Youth, Amateur, Select, Open, Youth Ranch and Open Ranch. Exhibitor must show both Saturday and Sunday. Exhibitor must show halter both days and a total of 3 classes. halter counts as one class.
- No penalty will be given in Ranch for bling on saddles, shirts, bands or fake tails.

General Rules

- Any one riding or leading a horse into the arena must be a member of Southern Illinois Equine Group.
- Negative Coggins are required on all horses.
- Stock/Hunter type horses Only-Quarter Horse, Paint, Appaloosa, Mustang, Thoroughbred, Warmblood, Pony.
- All exhibitors must sign a release of liability form, and release form must be on file at the registration desk before participating in show. Youth under the age of 18, the form must be signed by a parent/guardian.
- Tack changes between classes will be given 4 minutes. All tack changes must be declared at registration.
- Proper attire is required for each class-Western or English. Protective Gear is permissible and strongly recommended.
- Two-handing in the Western classes with a shank bit is an automatic disqualification. However two-handing is allowed with a snaffle bit or bosal on a junior horse, ages 2 to 5 years.
- Tie downs or any training device will not be allowed while showing.
- SIEG has the right to disqualify any exhibitor or horse. If at any time a handler or rider cannot control their horse, they will be removed from the arena. Exhibitors and or owner may be ejected for poor sportsmanship. No loud or disruptive coaching will be allowed in any class.
- Judge's decision is final. Protest may be made in writing the day of the show and must be accompanied by a \$25 fee. The fee will only be refunded if SIEG board approves the protest.
- No Smoking in any barn. No Smoking allowed in or near the arena area.
- SIEG is not responsible for any award not picked up the day of the show.
- Postdated checks are not allowed, and under certain circumstances a cash only payment may be required.
- All Premium Money won will be mailed.
- *Points break down per class 1st 5 points, 2nd 4 points, 3rd 3 points 4th 2 points 5th 1 points regardless of how many entered in class.
- *You are required to pick up your tack stalls before leaving or you will be fined

*Announcements made the day of the show will take precedence over any printed material.

*SIEG reserves the right to combine classes.

*All out of state horse must present health certificate.

* All horses must present a current coggins.

*Under Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, of damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.

*Judge's decision is final.

*All dogs must be on leash.

*Management reserves the right to bar any horse or rider for misconduct.
